

Nancy R. Wilson, Species and Miniature Narcissus

Dear Friends,

We had a disaster this winter. I had about 100 planted pots waiting to go outdoors when the weather cooled. The day we went to the barn to put them out we realized their new identification tags were gone! It turned out that a woodrat had carried them to her nest under the barn. Short of pulling down the barn, this daffodil season will be spent re-identification. We took in a lovely little terrier, hoping it was a woodrat killer, but he does not have a strong enough mouth to capture a cream puff. ‘Sprite’, ‘Towai’ and ‘Zip’ have multiplied enough for us to offer a few for sale. For those of you who ordered Trimon in 2009, it is now registered as ‘Yana’.

This year Walter Blom has had a good increase and several of his bulbs are offered at a lower price. He has four new introductions. ‘Golden Symphony’ 5 Y-Y and ‘Spring Serenade’ 5 Y-Y are two new triandrus hybrids which are much needed for exhibit. The other two are early blooming bulbocodiums with multiple flowers per bulb. They are ‘Golden Tiara’ 10 Y-Y which has deeply scalloped perianth segments and ‘Spring Medley’ 10 W-Y, the second bi-colored flower to be registered, the first to be Glenbrook Bulb Farms ‘Mitimoto’ which is offered as well.. It is a good grower with a large, brilliant greenish yellow corona. Both cultivars are very striking.
